The **30th Annual City of Orange Tree Lighting and Candlelight Procession** will be on December 8, 2024, at the City of Orange Plaza Park. This event will be attended by over 5,000 residents, friends, and local dignitaries. The Orange Community Master Chorale along with high school and local church choirs will be joined by a full orchestra and the St. John's Lutheran School Children's Choir to ring in the holiday season.

In past years, the City of Orange has funded the event. The City is currently experiencing a budget deficit that has impacted many of the community events that are important experiences for those who live in this historic and treasured city. While the City Council wants to continue funding these events, they have determined that it will not be possible now. This provides an opportunity for those who are willing and able to underwrite cherished events with the full support of the city council. We need your financial support.
